Visa Requirements VENEZUELA

Required Documents Checklist

ALL TRAVELERS must include the following documents in your package to G3:

- Your original valid signed passport, plus one photocopy of the information/photo page. The passport must have more than six months before expiry and must have at least FIVE blank visa pages (pages must be labeled Visas, not Amendments or Endorsements.) Please contact G3 if you need to have visa pages added to your passport.
- Non-US citizens must provide a copy of their Alien Registration Card (A.R.C.) or U.S. Visa and original I-94.
- One completed and signed visa application form (see attached).
- Two passport-style (2"x2") photographs taken within the last 6 months, on photo paper and with a plain white background.
- Copy of flight itinerary
- Copy of valid driver's license

BUSINESS TRAVELERS must also include:

- A business letter from their U.S. company. This letter must explain the purpose of the trip and provide a financial guarantee. It must be on letterhead and signed by a representative of the company other than the applicant. A sample is attached.
- Copy of the U.S. company's articles of incorporation or Certificate of Good Standing.
- A letter of invitation from the company to be visited in Venezuela. Faxed or scanned copies are acceptable; a sample is attached.
- Copy of the Venezuelan company's articles of incorporation.

FLIGHT CREW TRAVELERS must also include (in addition to all BUSINESS requirements listed above):

- Proof of permission to land in Venezuela. Faxed or scanned copies are acceptable.
- A list of all flight crew and passengers on the plane, including full name and nationality.

TOURIST TRAVELERS* must also include:

- A copy of a recent bank statement. Account numbers may be blacked out for privacy; do not obscure other information.
- A letter from the employer stating the applicant's job title and date of hire.

NOTES:

*U.S. Citizens do not require visas for tourist trips of 90 days or less. Visas are required for business trips to Venezuela.

These instructions are valid for residents of Texas, Kansas, New Mexico and Oklahoma.

Send all required documents and the completed Traveler Information form to G3 using a service with tracking such as FedEx or UPS.
